Safety Tips from NAR

TIP #1 Show properties before dark. If you are going to be working after hours, advise your associate or first-line supervisor of your schedule. If you must show a property after dark, turn on all lights and open shades prior to going inside with your client.

TIP #2 When you have a new client, ask him/her to stop by your office and complete a Prospect Identification Form (Find a copy online at nar.realtor/safety). Also, photocopy their driver’s license and retain this information at your office. Be certain to properly discard this personal information when you no longer need it.
