NAR Reacts to SCOTUR Ruling

With the Supreme Court issuing its ruling today on the leadership structure at the Federal Housing Finance Agency, NAR President Charlie Oppler [expressed appreciation](#) for Director Mark Calabria's efforts to advance GSE reform and expressed REALTORS®' commitment to promoting its utility model plan. The court declined to dismantle the agency but said restrictions on the president's ability to remove the FHFA director were unconstitutional, which is expected to result in a change in leadership.
