Congress Sends Covid-19 Rescue Bill for Biden’s Signature

The U.S. House of Representatives today passed the final version of the American Rescue Plan Act, sending it to President Biden for his signature. The \$1.9 trillion coronavirus relief bill contains a number of provisions that are priorities for REALTORS®, including rental assistance, small business loans, state and local funding, extended unemployment benefits, and new money for housing counseling and a housing assistance fund.
